Why use behaviour enriching devices?

Whether your dog has separation anxiety, destructive behaviour, or it barks a lot, all good dog trainers will suggest investing in great behaviour enriching devices. The first 20 minutes you leave your dog alone is the most stressful time. They're most likely to dig holes, bark, or try to escape. If you can give your dog a variety of behaviour enrichment devices to burn up those first 20 minutes, you've basically gone 90% of the way to curing your pet problems. For example, instead of giving them their breakfast in a bowl, wait until just before you're about to go to work, and get a few toys like the below.
